Physician Counts by State: MDs and DOs























Medicare Advantage Physician Counts by State: MDs and DOs







Managed Medicaid Physician Counts by State: MDs and DOs








Physician Count Comparison: Commercial and Managed Medicaid






2021 TO 2022 CHANGES
